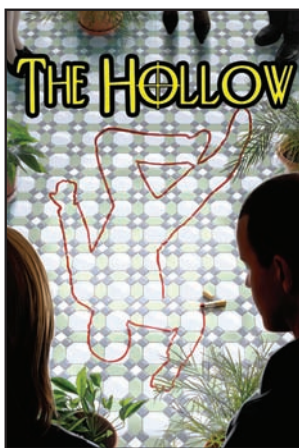

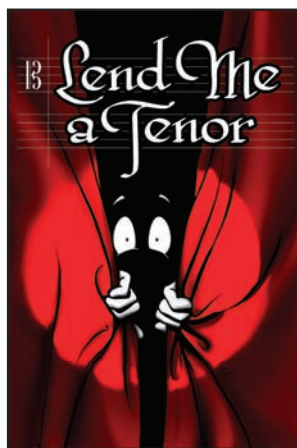


**Jan. 14 - Feb. 20, 2011**

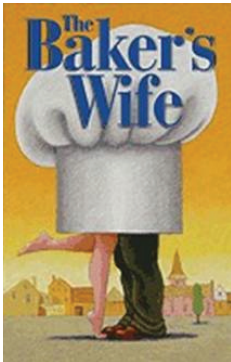
